HIGH SCHOOL SUCCESS PLAN

 - b. Personal goals- Do you want to join a team? Do you want to do a sport to help with weight loss? Do debate to help with speaking skills?
 - c. Career- What subjects will you choose? What will you do to push yourself in that career? Network with alumni from your school?
 - d. Other goals- Reduce the number of disciplinary infractions?
2. What clubs and service projects would you like to join or create? What initiatives would you like to start? How will you do it?
3. Is there any award or honour you will like to receive during your tenure?
4. Is there a title that you want to win for your school or represent them in a competition?
